

Equipment rental service for guided and self-guided activities only.

Equipment rental for free practice activities - NOT AVAILABLE HERE

Self-guided activity or experience:

An outdoor activity conducted without the supervision of a certified guide, but still safely supervised by an accredited service provider.

Participants (equipment renters) must:

1. Have the physical and cognitive abilities to practice the activity safely,
2. Know the basic technical requirements for the activity in question,
3. Know and respect the preventive safety rules,
4. Know how to use safety equipment,
5. Practice the activity within well-defined boundaries, trails and/or waterways,
6. Be back at the *Relais plein air* a minimum of 10 minutes before the end of the assigned time slot.

Guided Activity or Experience:

A well-defined outdoor activity that takes place under the supervision of a certified guide, within the boundaries of the site, trails and/or waterways, for a defined period of time.

Open practice (NOT AVAILABLE HERE):

Outdoor activity practiced independently, without the safe supervision of an accredited service provider. Open practice is not available at the Relais plein air.

Our outdoor equipment rental service is limited to guided and self-guided outdoor activities or experiences. It is not available for open practice activities.

This means that it is not available to people who do not meet our criteria of physical or cognitive ability to use the equipment safely.

The assessment of the participant's abilities as well as obtaining their formal commitment to respect the preventive safety instructions are mandatory.

Our employees have the duty and responsibility to refuse to rent our equipment to people they do not consider capable of using our equipment safely.

They also have the duty and responsibility to refuse to rent our equipment to people they do not consider sincere in their intentions to respect all safety instructions.

The assessment and decision of our staff is at their sole discretion.
